#### BIODIVERSITY 2014: my partner's profile Urska Levac (from Koper school)




I Interviewed Urska Levac last Friday. She is seventeen years old and comes from Koper high school.

## Anzhelika Danadzhy (from Prešeren school)




I interviewed Anzhelika Danadzhy from Preseren high school. She was born in 1997 in Ukraine, she loves Russia, in particular the language.

Last week I interviewed Petra Loredan. She comes from "Preseren" school, in Trieste and she is very funny. I've spent a nice day with her.



"Don't worry be happy" this is the motto of Sancin Sanja, a girl of Prešeren school of Trieste.



I interviewed Sanja Marija Viviani. She is from Trieste and she's very friendly.


